Regarding Filing a Final Appeal on Case for Violation of the Antimonopoly Act

As announced in “Regarding Judgment (Appeal Hearing) on Case for Violation of the Antimonopoly Act” dated March 2, 2023, Kajima Corporation (the “Company”) received a judgment to dismiss the appeal regarding the case under public prosecution for violation of the Antimonopoly Act over a construction project for the Chuo Shinkansen led by Central Japan Railway Company from the Tokyo High Court on March 2, 2023.

The Company finds it very disappointing that its assertion was not affirmed in the appeal hearing following the first hearing. Having closely examined the details of the judgment of the appeal hearing with its defense counsel, the Company is unable to agree with the judgment, and has therefore resolved at the Board of Directors’ Meeting held today to file a final appeal to the Supreme Court.

It is very regrettable for the Company that the incident has caused the great concern to our stockholders, customers, and all stakeholders, and the Company sincerely appreciates the continued support and understanding.

Since this issue has only minor impact on financial performance, no change is to be made to the forecast of consolidated financial results for the fiscal year ending March 31, 2023 announced on February 14, 2023.
